

# V-Manager 4.0

## Setting Up Local Workstations

Unlike the V-Manager 3.0 series, V-Manager 4.0 requires the installation of Microsoft Active X Controls on each user's local workstation.

Installing these files on individual workstations will allow V-Manager to run more efficiently on the network.

To install the files, simply follow these steps on each user's computer:

1. Select Start | File | Run | Browse
2. Locate the V-Manager directory (typically called "vmanager" and found on a network drive)
3. Double-click to select the program SETUPLOCAL.EXE
4. Click on OK. This will install the necessary files on the workstation's hard drive.

Attempting to run V-Manager 4.0 on a workstation where SETUPLOCAL.EXE has not been successfully installed will result in error messages stating that "DLL files are missing".
